Royal Oaks World School conducted the Inter house English Elocution Competition on 4th August 2018.


This was an attempt to promote English Speaking Skills, in terms of pronunciation, delivery, voice modulation and to develop English in its spoken form.

Participants expressed their thoughts through their speeches on various burning issues around the world to bring about a greater global awareness among the pupils of the school.








The Interhouse Quiz Competition was held for Classes 5 and 6 at Royal Oaks World School on 15th December 2018.

This activity is conducted for all classes regularly to encourage students to look beyond their textual knowledge and establish a relationship between theory and the application of learnt concepts.








I t was time to eliminate hatred by lightning the diya of happiness in each heart.
