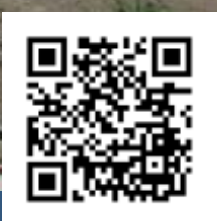

This was an attempt to promote English Speaking Skills, in terms of pronunciation, delivery, voice modulation and to develop English in its spoken form.

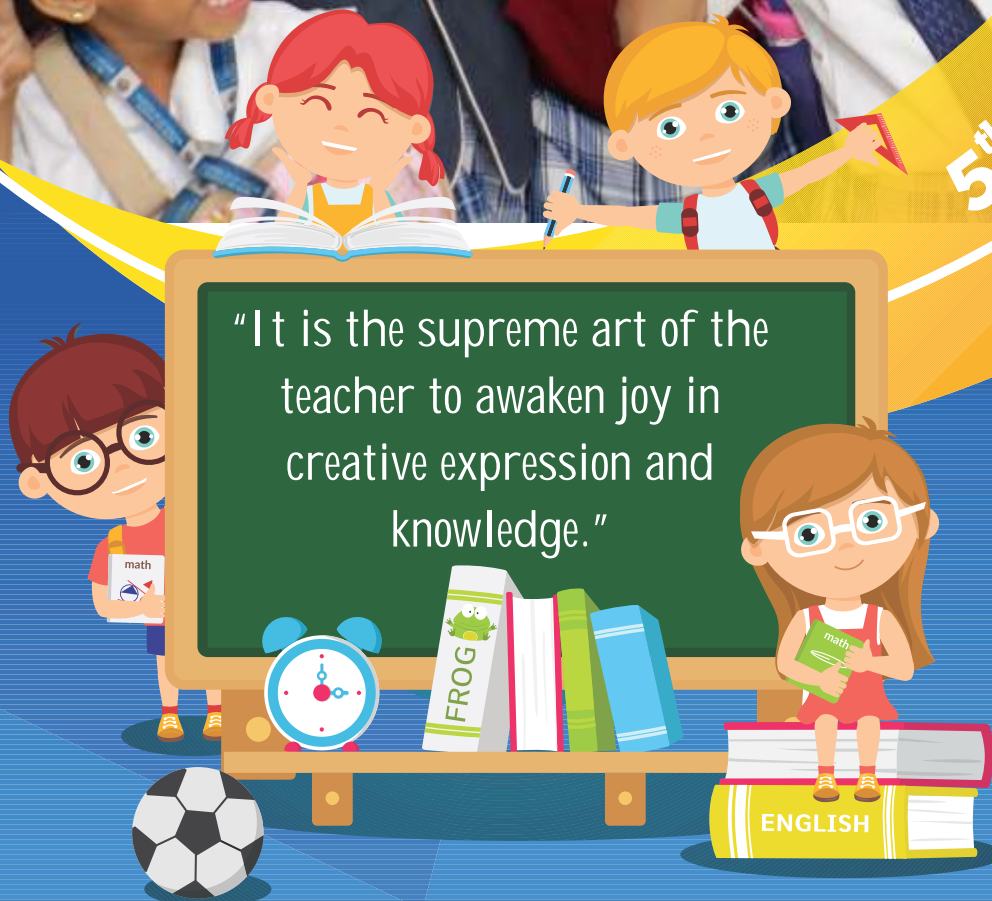
The poems selected were varied and very enjoyable. The confidence, expression and talent of the young ones made the event truly memorable.

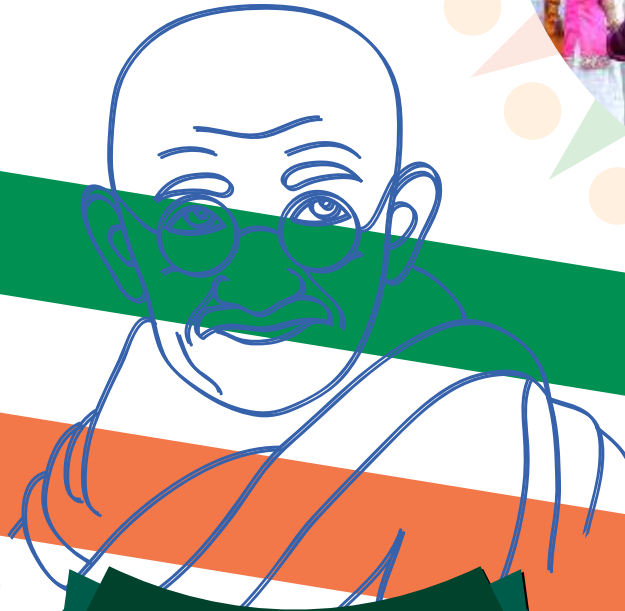
MARATHI DECLAMATION

took place in the true spirit of competitiveness. In the end, it was Kingfisher House that bagged the championship trophy leaving us all satisfied with another athletic meet completed.

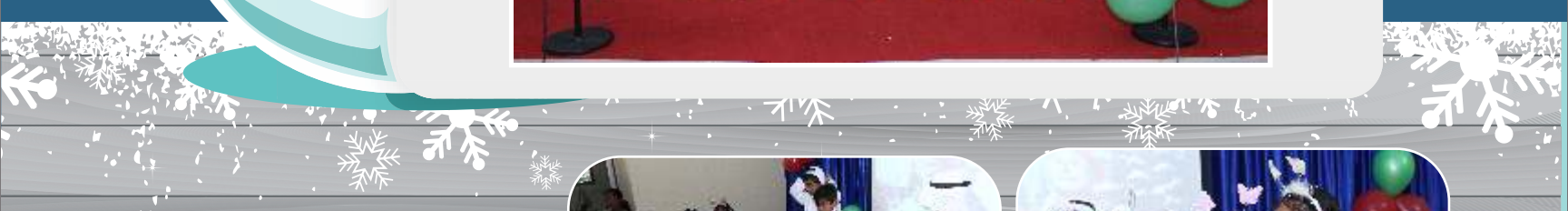


Christmas Celebration
