<u>NOUN</u> Name of a person, place, thing or idea. Eg- Daniel, London, table, hope. - <i>Mary</i> uses a blue <i>pen</i> for her <i>notes</i>	<u>PRONOUN</u> A pronoun is used in place of a noun or noun phrase to avoid repetition. Eg. I, you. It, we, us, them, those. -I want <i>her</i> to dance with <i>me</i>
<u>ADJECTIVE</u> Describes, modifies or gives more information about a noun or pronoun. Eg-cold, happy, young, two, fun. -The <i>little</i> girl has a <i>pink</i> hat	VERB Shows an action or a state of being. Eg- go, speak, eat, live, are, is -I <i>listen</i> to the word and then <i>repeat</i> it.
<u>ADVERB</u> Modifies a verb, an adjective or another adverb. It tells how (often), where, when. Eg- slowly, very, always, well, too -Yesterday, I ate my lunch quickly.	<u>PREPOSITION</u> Shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another word. Eg – at, on, in, from, with, about -I left my keys <i>on</i> the table <i>for</i> you.
<u>CONJUNCTION</u> Joins two words, ideas, phrases together and shows how they are connected. Eg – and, on, but, because, yet, so -I was hot and tired but still finished it.	INTERJECTION A word or phrase that expresses a strong emotion. It is a short exclamation. Eg – Ouch! Hey! Oh! Watch out! -Wow! I passed my English exam.
