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Articles

An article is a word that modifies or defines the noun being referenced. In English, there are 3 articles: the, a & an.

The word "the" is used when you're referring to a specific noun, or with plural nouns.

For example: Please hand me **the** book.

His mom carried **the** little kittens to **the** barn.

Whereas, the word "a" (or an) is used when you're not referring to a specific noun, but one of a general group.

For example: Please hand me **a** book.

She wanted **a** dog.

The word "an" is used when you're not referring to a specific noun, and the noun (or its modifiers) begins with a vowel or vowel sound.

For example: Please give me **an** hour.

It became **an** immigrant haven.

Because the word "hour" begins with a silent 'h', the word "an" is used instead of "a".

Some more examples of articles: **The** boys wanted to dance with **the** girls.

The little boy wanted to dance with **a** little girl.

The little boy wanted to dance with **an** angel.
