## **Articles**

These articles worksheets will help you practice how to use the indefinite articles, **a/an**, and the definite article, **the**.

#### A/an

We use **a/an** for nouns that are *not* specific, when we can refer to *any one* of a certain kind of thing.

For example: I want a cookie! (You want *any one* of the cookies , not a specific cookie. So, you use **a**.)

The word "cookie" begins with a consonant sound, so we use **a**. If the word begins with a vowel sound, we use **an**.

For example: The scientist had **an** idea.

(We do not know anything about the idea, so it is not specific. The word "idea" starts with a vowel sound, so we use **an**.)

## The

We use **the** for *specific* nouns, when we know *exactly which* thing we are talking about. We use **the** for singular or plural nouns.

For example: Jack fell asleep in **the** green chair. (We know *exactly which specific* chair we are talking about.)

#### **No Article**

Remember that in some cases, we do not use an article. When we are talking about something *in general* or when we mention *a city or country*, we do not use an article.

For example: Parties are a lot of fun! (Parties *in general* are fun.)

> I went to Australia last year. (Australia is *a country*, so we do not use an article.)






