
Definition of Article

Articles are basically a type of determiners.

Determiner covers many classes of words in which there are articles (definite and indefinite articles), adjectives and pronouns.

Types of Articles

There are three main articles – 'a', 'an' and 'the'. These three articles can be divided in two classes.



1. <u>Definite Article (The)</u> 'The' is known as definite article because it is used to point out specific person or thing. e.g.- The Moon and the Sun etc.

Uses of 'The'
